

Printing Instructions For Equal Parents Week Rally Flier

There are two versions of the Equal Parents Week Rally Flier available for general public printing. The first version is for printing on standard office paper sized 8.5" by 11". The second version is for printing on "tabloid" paper size 11" x 17".

Each flier has a version number printed on it and the current version for Equal Parents Week Rally Flier is 1.1. The fliers and printing instructions are available from these web addresses:

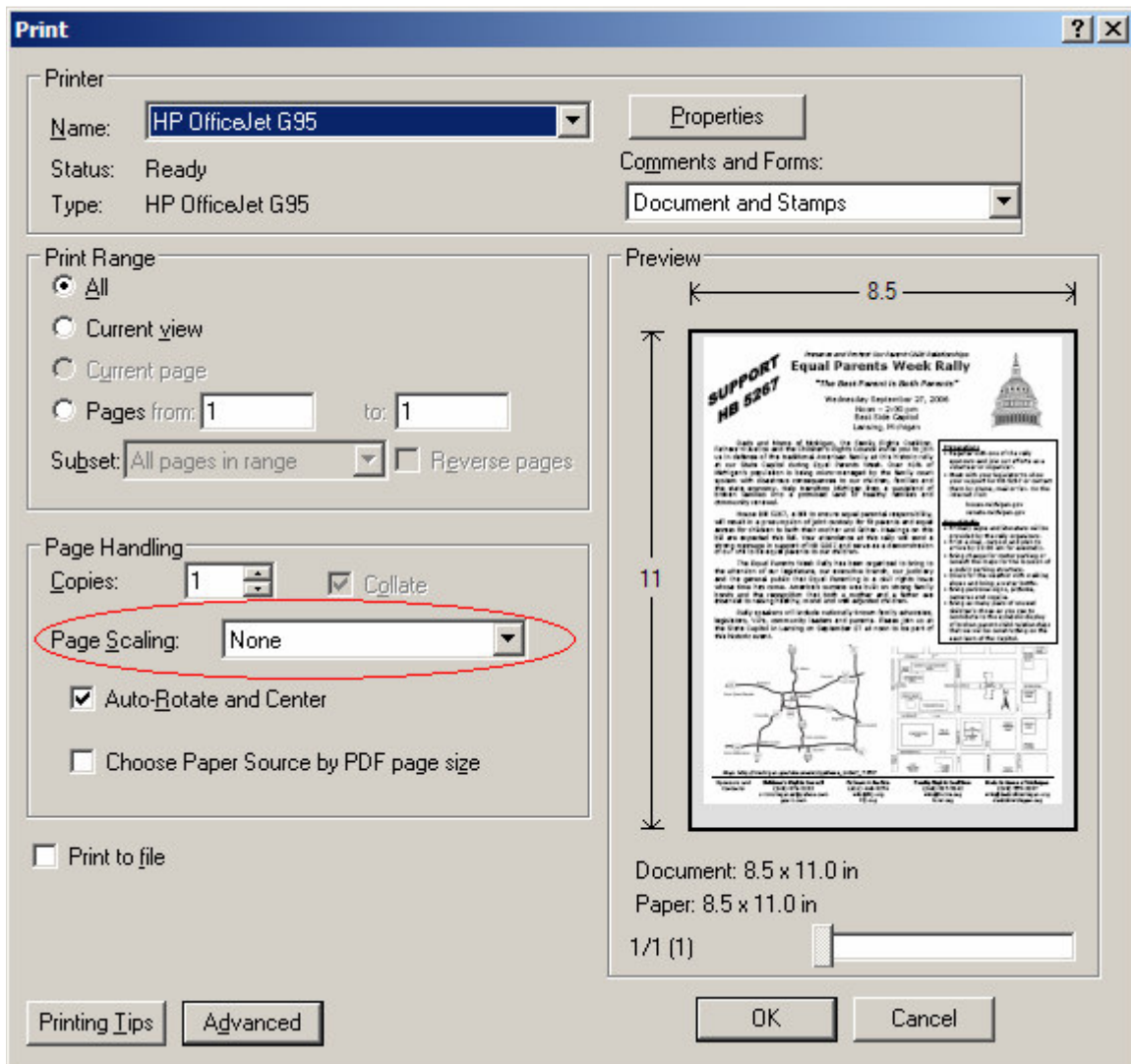

Printing the 8.5" x 11" Equal Parents Week Rally Flier

The flier is being distributed as a pdf file and when printing the document you should take care to make sure there is no clipping or scaling of the document. We have found that if you set the Page Scaling to None in the print dialog box you will print a well formatted flier preserving the intended margins.



We are encouraging you to print the document on lime green paper as this color is very visible and striking and provides a nice contrast with the black ink. The following scanned photo is representative of the appearance but is drabber in appearance than the actual printed flier we used. If you have an existing stock of white paper or prefer another color by all means use the materials you prefer, but experience has proven lime green provides the best appearance for a black and white print in our opinion.

House Bill 5267, a bill to ensure equal parental responsibility, will result in a presumption of joint custody for fit parents and equal access for children to both their mother and father. Hearings on this bill are expected this fall. Your attendance at this rally will send a strong message in support of HB 5267 and serve as a demonstration of our will to be equal parents to our children.

The Equal Parents Week Rally has been organized to bring to the attention of our legislature, our executive branch, our judiciary and the general public that Equal Parenting is a civil rights issue whose time has come. America's success was built on strong family bonds and the recognition that both a mother and a father are essential to raising healthy, moral and well adjusted children.


Rally speakers will include nationally-known family advocates, legislators, VIPs, community leaders and parents. Please join us at the State Capitol in Lansing on September 27 at noon to be part of this historic event.

Preparations


- Register with one of the rally sponsors and join our efforts as a volunteer or organizer.

Day of Rally

- Primary signs and literature will be provided by the rally organizers.
- Print a map, carpool and plan to arrive by 11:00 am for assembly.
- Bring change for meter parking or consult the maps for the location of a public parking structure.
- Dress for the weather with walking shoes and bring a water bottle.
- Bring personal signs, pictures, cameras and regalia.
- Bring as many pairs of unused children's shoes as you can to contribute to the symbolic display of broken parent-child relationships that we will be constructing on the east lawn of the Capitol.

Printing the 11" x 17" Equal Parents Week Rally Flier

The 11" by 17" version of the Equal Parents Week Flier is intended for display on bulletin boards kiosks etc. The content of this large version of the fliers is the same as the 8.5" by 11" version.

To print this large version of the flier you need to save the file to a floppy disk and take it to Kinkos or your preferred copy shop and have them print the pdf file direct to their printer. The fonts and formatting have been altered to conform to larger size paper which has a different aspect ratio than 8.5" x 11" office paper. Copies this size on color paper cost about 40 cents at Kinkos and perhaps are cheaper at other shops. If your vendor wants to charge you extra for printing from a pdf file, go somewhere else where they will not add this extra charge.

It looks quite impressive being twice the size of the 8.5" x 11" flier. Don't forget the official color of the flier is **BLUE** - nothing else will be tolerated.
